CONFIRMATION CORE TEAM LEADER VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTION

Description:

The Confirmation Core Team Leader helps to plan and implement four Super Sunday Confirmation Formation Days during the school year. A Confirmation Core Team Leader will attend most all Super Sundays, plan one of these formation days, and lead a small group of teens in discussion. A Confirmation Core Team Leader will be asked to be a role model of faith and regular presence in the lives of Our Lady of Grace youth.

Volunteer Functions:

- Attend most all Super Sundays from 1:00-6:30pm on Sundays, including preparation meeting at 12:00pm.
- Lead a small faith sharing group with another Core Team leader.
- Plan and implement one Super Sunday during the year with a planning team of other Core Team Leaders.
 This includes meeting approximately one month prior to the night, arranging speakers or 'Proclaim' talks, creating small group discussion questions, and distributing a schedule of the day to other Core Team Leaders.
- Help lead the Spirit & Fire Confirmation Retreat in late February as a small group facilitator.
- Lead activities, play games, or give talks when needed.
- Help set up and clean up each Super Sunday.
- Develop appropriate relationships with youth in order to encourage them in faith and give them a faith mentor with whom they interact on a regular basis.

Responsibilities of all Core Team Members:

- Be a full, active, and conscious participant in your Catholic faith, including attending Mass and praying regularly. We must practice what we preach.
- Be passionate about sharing our Catholic faith with youth.
- Attend required Safe Conduct Protocol Trainings, submit required background checks, and adhere to diocesan safety protocols for interacting with youth in person and online.
- Do ministry under the direction and standards of the Coordinator(s) of Youth Ministry and Pastor of Our Lady of Grace.
- Work as a team with other Core Team members, avoiding pitfalls like trying to solve problems on your own, being disrespectful to other Team members, or not challenging each other to be better.
- Communicate well with the youth ministry office by reading messages and responding appropriately. Also, bring ideas, suggestions or concerns to the attention of the Coordinator(s) of Youth Ministry.
- Share your gifts to grow one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic Church.
